- Always ask a trusted adult before you go on the computer
- Tell an adult if you are unhappy about something on the computer
- Use the websites that you know are safe and recommended (e.g. BBC and CBBC)
- Only talk to people that you know
- Send friendly and polite messages
- Never give out your name or email address
- Don't tell people on the internet where you live or where you go to school
- Don't click on an icon that you have not seen before or told by an adult not to touch
- Do not respond to pop ups
- ***Be smart, safe, trustworthy and have fun!***



Knutsford School E-Safety Code Key Stage Two

We promise to follow this code to keep us safe online

- Always make sure you have permission to access the internet
- If someone is unkind STOP, BLOCK and TELL
- Use the report Abuse button to report any unkind comments, ask if you need help finding the button
- Tell a trusted adult if something has upset you online
- Don't share passwords, usernames and other personal details with anyone, except a trusted adult
- Use the websites that you know are safe and recommended (e.g. BBC and CBBC)
- Never take part in any cyber bullying BUT report any incidents of it
- Ask permission from people before you include them in your 'chat' group
- Don't meet up with people that you have met online
- Don't click on pop ups
- Always ask permission from an adult before going into a chat room, when using it for the first time
